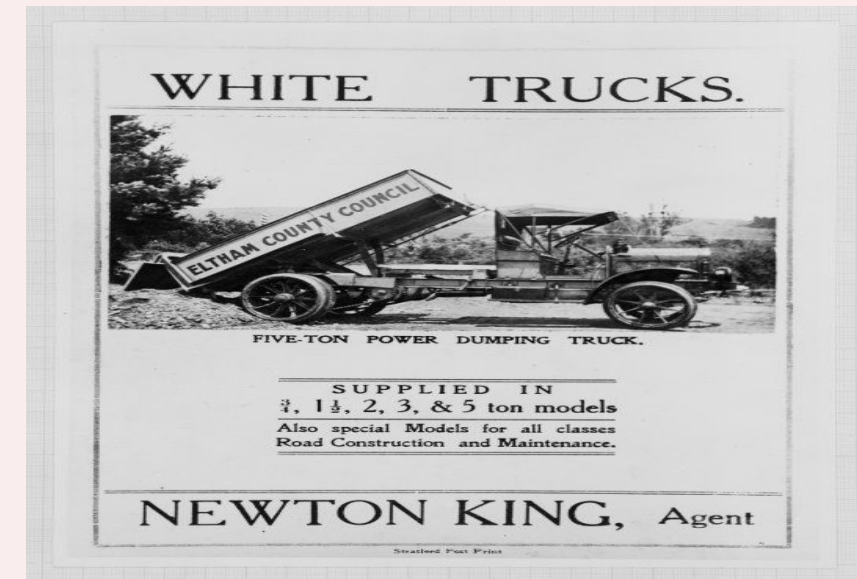

THOSE WERE THE DAYS PEOPLE HISTORY

King, Sir Frederick Truby (1858-1938) was a famous NZ born, Edinburgh trained physician and psychologist. He devised the Plunket Society for improving the health of mothers and their babies. Truby Kind was the son of Thomas King (1821-1893) who was a member of the committee of colonists at Plymouth, Devon which made detailed arrangements for the NZ company settlement at New Plymouth. He became a merchant and land owner in the Taranaki, and also represents Taranaki in the NZ parliament for three years. His older brother Newton King (1856-1926) became a very wealthy businessman and founded a large stock and station firm "Newton King Ltd".
