## Moments of World History

(Pre history to modern day)

### Sumer (4300-2334 BC)

The world's first civilisation arose in Sumer. The ancient name of Southern Mesopotamia during the Uruk period (4300—3000 BC) These fertile, low-lying marshes, the land had to be drained and irrigated before it could be farmed. Flood barriers had to be built. Villages worked together to do this. These villages united to form towns, usually on the site of the shrine of the local god. These towns grew to form cities. The first city's were built in about 3500. Religion was more dominant in Sumerian
