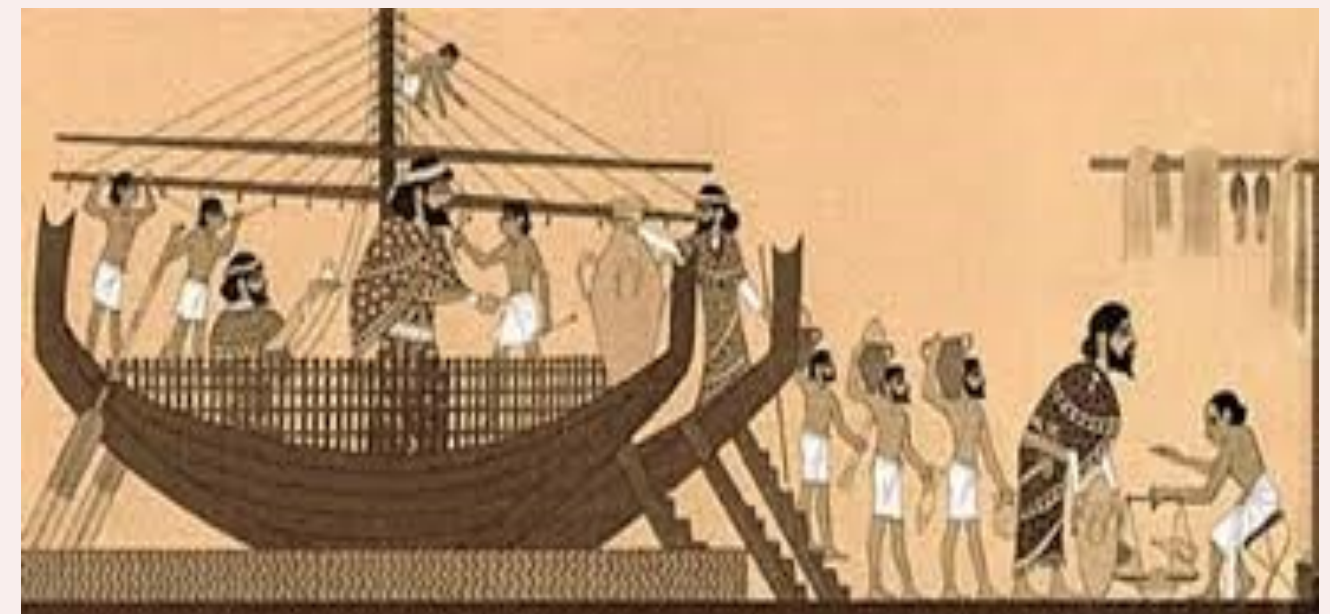

**(Pre history to modern day)**

**Phoenicians and Carthaginians (900-480 BC)**

The Greeks were not the only people to colonise the Mediterranean during the first millennium BC/ The Phoenicians, a seafaring power from the Levant, were simultaneously founding colonies in Cyprus, North Africa, Southern Spain, the Balears, Sardinia and Sicily. By the 7th century the most powerful of these colonies was Carthage in present day Tunisia. When Phoenicia was itself conquered in the 6th century, the colonies became independent and Carthage emerged as the centre of a new empire in the Western Mediterranean.
