


GREAT PEOPLE OF THE BIBLE QUIZ

Neolithic and Bronze age Europe (6500-500 BC)

Agriculture did not spread smoothly or quickly through Europe. It took time to develop crop strains suited to the colder wetter climates of the continent. The switch from hunting and gathering took place over a long period, with many cultures developing a semi-sedentary semi-nomadic existence before eventually forming permanent settlements. Often agriculture spread due to migrants colonising an area. In other cases indigenous hunter gatherers were forced to adopt farming due to a decline in availability of local food sources.
